










Memorial ACTe Musuem – Human Zoos



Temporary Exhibition: from June 29th to December 30th 2018

THE EXHIBITION:

- 1st time at the Memorial ACTe
- Nearly five centuries of history
- About 400 pieces of work spread over 7500 sqft
- This exhibition has been seen in several countries: Paris, France; Washington State, USA; Glasgow, Scotland; Liège, Belgium, etc.

EXHIBITION CONTENT:

- Exhibition tells the story of women, men and children from the five continents and displayed in the West at colonial exhibitions, fairs, circuses, zoos, etc. between 1460 and 1940






THE COMMISSIONERS:
